Minutes

**Purpose:** To make recommendations to the Parks & Recreation Commission pertaining to the maintenance and operation of the Neenah Harbor.

1. **Call to Order:** Chair Erickson called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M.
2. **Approval of Minutes:** Rather/McCoy motioned to approve the minutes from the June 3, 2024 meeting. Motion carried.
3. **Appearances:** None
4. **Weed Harvesting:** 16 man-hours, 6 loads of weeds @ 2,500 lbs. were removed from the harbor.
5. **Doty/Kimberly Point Park Seawall Update:** Director Kading distributed current pictures of the Doty Park shoreline project indicating that the project should be substantially completed in the first week of November. Kimberly Point borings have been completed and will be used to design the shoreline protection and stabilization. Design, engineering, and permitting is scheduled to begin in 2026 with construction during the fall of 2027.
6. **Kimberly Point Lighthouse Fundraising:** Fundraising efforts have begun with the goal of raising 50% (\$280,000) of the estimated total construction costs. Construction specs are expected to be developed in late spring with a late summer bid let/award and construction to begin in October/November.
7. **Budgeting for Boat Slip Evaluation:** Boats have gotten bigger, and the 8' stalls are not being rented. We plan to evaluate our current infrastructure and evaluate the benefit of improving and enlarging the stalls to meet demand.
8. **Announcements and Future Agenda Items**
  - Buoy placement was incorrect this year and needs to be adjusted for next year's boating season.
  - A tree has fallen from private property and is affecting the navigational channel. How can we get it removed?
  - There is potential of placing an informational buoy marking the location of the Council Tree.
